Our initiatives include


- Employment of a Head of Department (Student Engagement) to support student engagement in learning to meet the whole school targets identified above. \$115,689 plus contribution from IPS funding source (\$33,703).

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Building staff capability in high quality engaging pedagogical practices to demonstrate consistent systematic use of the MSS collaboratively developed approach to learning walls and guided reading practices;
- Consistent implementation of the schools Code of Conduct for students and Positive Behaviour for Learning strategy;
- Consistent implementation of whole school attendance process to ensure students have the best chance at meeting whole school targets;
- Identification and support for students at risk of disengaging (Behaviour, Attendance, Well-being);
- Facilitate support for complex case management of students;
- Building staff capability across all levels through Mentoring, Coaching and Feedback Framework processes.
